Over 30 people helped in three different shifts. Along with congregational members, a number of those in the community also helped with this project. Thanks be to God, we were able to raise the full \$3900 that covered the cost for the food. To God be the glory!

Re-Vitality: A week and a half ago ten congregational members met on a beautiful evening outside to discuss the core values of this congregation. While we had a four month hiatus, so far we have done work on the importance of strategic planning in a congregation, building consensus, and figuring out the various resources God has given us as a congregation. Next month we will continue our discussion of core values. Please pray for this planning process, so that we can better discern and carry out God's mission for St. Paul's.

Food Pantry News: We served 20 households last week; 47 adults and 12 children. 4 new households. We are in DESPERATE NEED of help on our next pantry day on <u>Aug. 19th 1 p.m.-3:30 p.m.</u> We need 3-5 able bodied people who are able to *lift/move packed food boxes into trunks of our patrons' cars; *move carts of boxes back and forth; *lift and move tables. If we don't have enough volunteers, WE WILL BE FORCED TO CANCEL for this date. We are a 501c3 non-profit, so if your employer allows paid time-off for charity work, we qualify! We will also sign school forms for students who need community service hours.
