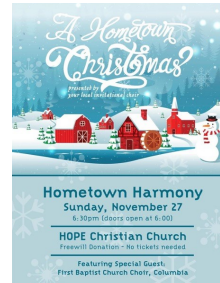
Youth Christmas Tree Decorating

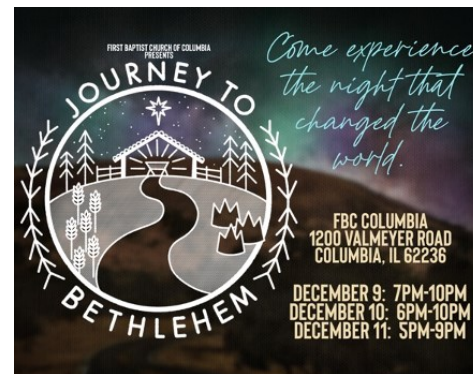
